Dear Ordeal Candidate:

Congratulations! You have been approved by your Scoutmaster and elected by the Scouts of your troop to become a member of the Order of the Arrow, Scouting's National Honor Society. Membership in the Order of the Arrow not only marks you as one of the best in Scouting, but opens up additional Scouting opportunities for you including National Conferences, Training, High Adventure Opportunities, and new leadership experiences.

Your election was the first step in your induction into the OA. Your next step is to complete the Ordeal. The Ordeal is a 24-hour test of your strength and will. The Ordeal is not a test to see if you are worthy for membership in the Order, you've passed that test already by being elected by your fellow Scouts.

Your next opportunity to undergo the Ordeal is at the Fall Conclave, August 13-15 at Camp Wilderness. If you do not complete the Ordeal within one year from your election, you will have to be elected by your troop again.

If you attend Conclave plan to arrive Friday night beginning at 6:00, but no later than 9pm. Immediately upon arrival you should register at the Black Building. There will be no dinner served on Friday evening, so you should eat before checking in. Ask your Scoutmaster if others were elected in your troop so you can arrange carpooling if you want.

The Lodge Annual Business Meeting will occur on Sunday Morning. Camp Cleanup will follow the meeting -- you may depart once camp cleanup is completed (around 11am - noon). There will be worship services held during the weekend.

Come prepared to spend the first night of your Ordeal under the stars. You will not be allowed to have a fire Friday night, so don't bring matches or lighters with you. You will need a sleeping bag, ground cloth (plastic tarp), and your raincoat or poncho. The weather can vary greatly from very cold to very warm. Check the weather forecast and bring enough clothing. During the Ordeal you will be expected to do physical labor, this may involve lifting, walking, reaching and other strenuous activity. If you are physically incapable or concerned about performing these activities, please contact the Health Officer upon your check-in Friday night and we'll make adjustments as needed. We are asking that you bring your health form. Please also let the health officer know at check-in if you brought medications with you.

You should bring a tent for Saturday night or plan to tent with a buddy. You will want to wear old work clothes Friday night and Saturday, but you will need your Scout uniform for Saturday evening and Sunday. A pair of work gloves for Saturday is strongly suggested. Showers are available and all eating utensils, plates are provided.

The total cost for the August Conclave is \$40 if pre-registered by August 1 (\$45 otherwise). The cost includes your: food, OA Handbook, Lodge Flap (patch), conclave patch, Ordeal Sash, induction costs, Pa-Hin Lodge Dues, and other materials.

You may wish to bring extra money to purchase items at the Lodge trading post. The trading post will offer many OA items including special patches, OA shirts, and other goods.

### **Things You Should Bring**

- Class 'A' Scout Uniform
- Sleeping Bag
- Ground Cloth/Plastic Tarp
- Rain gear
- Cold weather gear
- Tent
- Shower Kit
- Work Clothes
- Water Bottle
- Work Gloves
- Good boots
- Flashlights
- Prescription Medicine in original container

### **Things You Shouldn't Bring**

- Food/Snacks
- Matches or Lighter – you will not be allowed to have a fire Friday night
- Portable Electronics – like iPods, video games, etc
- Cell Phones are discouraged
- Sheath knives
- Hatchets, axes, tools

### **Things you Might want to Bring**

- Camera – limited opportunities to use though
- Air or Foam mattress
- Day Pack or regular Backpack –may be easier to carry your sleeping bag and ground cloth Friday
- Notebook, pencil, pen

Also enclosed is a “Spirit of the Arrow” booklet. Please read this carefully before arriving at the conclave.
